

Tip of the Month: Considering a short break before practising estate agency work again?

The <u>annual renewal exercise</u> for property agents to renew their registrations for year 2020 will be held from 1st to 31st October 2019.

In this month's tip, we share what agents should take note of if they decide not to renew their registration during the upcoming exercise, but could have the intention of practising estate agency work after taking a break.


Agents who are not renewing their registrations for year 2020 with their current property agencies should complete the following steps:



Note: If you choose not to renew your property agent registration for year 2020, your registration will be valid until <u>31 December 2019</u>. You will not be able to conduct estate agency work from 1 January 2020.

For agents who submit a salesperson registration application after taking a break

The process to re-register as a property agent depends on how long an individual has been deregistered as an agent.
