UPDATE ON LICENSING AND REGISTRATION EXERCISE FOR ESTATE AGENTS AND SALESPERSONS

As at 1 January 2015, the Council for Estate Agencies (CEA) has licensed 1,369 estate agents and registered 30,830 salespersons.

2 Out of the 30,830 registered salespersons, 3,006 are new entrants to the industry. 3,959 salespersons did not renew their registration.

3 In the previous year's renewal exercise, there were 1,425 licensed estate agents and 31,783 registered salespersons.

4 The number of registered salespersons registered at the end of each renewal exercise over the last four years is shown in Table 1.
